A Selection of Local Walks

- **To the Warren (local walk by the river, 1 mile)**

Come for a stroll along this gem of a walk which is only a hop, skip and jump away from Radnor House. A delight in all seasons, the old railway line follows the wooded banks of the River Wye to an expansive riverside meadow known as 'The Warren'.

- **A short walk on part of Offa's Dyke (5 miles)**

This walk offers an excellent insight to the surrounding Hay-on-Wye area and showcases what is on our doorstep. The walk goes past numerous historic spots including the famous Offa's Dyke path.

- **The Black Hill (5 miles)**

This walk is in the Black Mountains, in the section that lies over the country border in Herefordshire. The Black Hill was made famous in the novel of the same name by Bruce Chatwin. It is an idyllic walk with spectacular views, and includes the secluded Olchon Valley. The walk starts a half hour drive from here, along country lanes through Craswall and parts of the Golden Valley.

- **Four Waterfalls Walk (5 miles)**

A walk along four powerful waterfalls, all different in character, in deep, wooded ravines along the Hepste and Mellte rivers in the Brecon Beacons National Park. Two possible start points, both accessed by a narrow country road that links Ystradfellte with the A4059.
